

2006 ENERGY STAR INDOOR AIR PACKAGE LEADERSHIP AWARD

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency recognized Aspen Homes of Colorado, Inc., with an Indoor Air Package Leadership Award at E-Star Colorado's 2006 ENERGY STAR Summit.
